There was no padding of the schedule, which was evident with last week's meeting with No. 16 California (Pa.) Although the Storm was visibly battered in the game, the team lined up against one of the nation's top teams without reservation and is hoping the challenge will pay future dividends for the program.

QUICK NOTES

- Lake Erie held the nationally-ranked Vulcans to just six points in the second half, including a scoreless fourth quarter.
- Kyle Kordich and Onesiaum Glass netted 44 rushing yards.
- Dave Romeo and Demetrius Gray combined for 172 yards on kickoff returns.
- Demetrius Gray totaled a team-leading 118 all-purpose yards.
- Bill Finucan and Jordan McGhee had five tackles apiece.
- Finucan and Jonathan Zyznar recorded a sack.
- Vince Hug totaled 362 yards with 10 punts. His longest punt was 41 yards - his second longest of the season.

IN THE BEGINNING ...

- February 4, 2006 - Michael T. Victor is named the 11th president of Lake Erie College.
- February 2006 - President Victor forms a committee to research the feasibility of starting a football program.
- July 22, 2006 - The Board of Trustees grants approval to start the football program.
- August 9, 2006 - Mark McNellie becomes the first football coach in Lake Erie College history, leaving his position of assistant head coach at Mercyhurst College.
- September 1, 2006 - Coach McNellie begins the recruitment of what will become Lake Erie's first-ever football recruiting class.
- January 2007 - Gerald Hazzard is hired as the offensive coordinator.
- February 2007 - Lake Erie enters a three-way agreement with the City of Painesville and the Painesville City School District to make Jack Britt Memorial Stadium in Recreation Park the site of its home contests.
- March 2007 - Renovation of Lake Erie College's locker room begins. The renovation project consists of \$450,000 of improvements, including lockers, showers, bathrooms, carpet, heating, air conditioning and a training room.
- June 2007 - Lake Erie passes the first exploratory phase of its movement to NCAA Division II. The College enters its second year of the exploratory phase with the 2007-08 academic year.
- July 1, 2007 - Ian Formaz is hired as the Storm's offensive line coach.
- August 11, 2007 - The club football team reports to campus for the start of training camp.
- September 1, 2007 - One year to the day of its inception, the Storm football team plays its first club game against the Central Canadian All Stars, winning 56-0.
- November 4, 2007 - The team finishes the club season with a 45-14 win against Case Western Reserve JV, posting a record of 7-2 for the season.
- January 1, 2008 - Mike Krahe is hired as an assistant defensive coach, later evolving into the team's linebackers coach.
- February 6, 2008 - The Storm's first official varsity schedule for 2008 is released to the public, including 11 total games with seven against NCAA Division II competition.
- April 12, 2008 - Lake Erie plays its first spring game in program history at Perry High School.
- July 1, 2008 - Nick Postma is hired as the team's secondary coach.
- July 24, 2008 - Via a conference call with the NCAA, Lake Erie College is granted acceptance as an NCAA Division II provisional member as of Sept. 1, 2008.
- August 6, 2008 - The first Storm varsity team reports to preseason training camp.
- August 8, 2008 - The Storm holds its first-ever varsity practice at Painesville Kiwanis Recreation Park.
- August 28, 2008 - The Storm played Gannon University at 7 p.m. at Jack Britt Memorial Stadium in its first varsity game in program history, which aired on SportsTime Ohio.

GAME NOTES

AGAINST SAINT JOSEPH'S: This is the first meeting between the two schools in program history.

SJC CONNECTION: There is no known connection between the Lake Erie College coaching staff and the Saint Joseph's College football program.

RETURN HOME: The Storm returns home after being on the road the past two weeks. Today's game marks the first of four straight in Painesville, Ohio in front of a home crowd at Jack Britt Memorial Stadium.

SECOND-HALF SHOWDOWN: Lake Erie College has been a second-half team this season, improving its statistics across the board in the final two periods. After three games, the Storm has scored just seven points in the first half as compared to 36 in the second half. The Storm defense has also gotten tougher in the second half, holding opponents to an average of just 6.3 points. The Storm is also more likely to convert on a fourth down in the second half. All seven of the team's fourth down conversions this season have occurred in the later half. Likewise, seven of the team's 12 third down conversions have also been in the second half. Additionally, the Storm has a greater time of possession, having the ball an average of three minutes more in the final half as compared to the game's opening 30 minutes.

GROWTH CHART: Storm freshman quarterback Sean Bedevelsky has shown much progress at the collegiate level. After a combined nine turnovers in the first two games, he totaled zero turnovers against nationally-ranked California (Pa.) last week.

"Sean is growing up in his role," said Lake Erie College head coach Mark McNellie. "He's continuing to mature and is becoming more of a leader as the season progresses. He's in a difficult role to begin with, and being thrust into that role as a freshman, he's handling it quite well."

KYLE GLASS: The freshman offensive lineman put in a solid performance on the road at California (Pa.).

"He has been exceptional for us," said McNellie. "He has developed into a quiet leader who goes out and competes day in and day out. With experience, he will only continue to improve and we're looking forward to witnessing that progress."

MEAN GREEN: Freshman David Greenslade has been called upon in several capacities this season, earning starts at both tackle and guard positions.

"It hasn't mattered what position we've put him at, he has really stepped up and his play has been huge," said McNellie. "He's been a steady performer each week. Because of injuries on the team, we've asked him to do some different things and he's been willing to accept the challenges we've put in front of him without question."

NEXT WEEK: The Storm remains at home to take on Adrian (Mich.) at 1 p.m. who is 1-1 headed into this week.

UPCOMING EVENTS: Lake Erie College is participating in NCAA Football's 11th Annual Take A Kid To The Game (TAKG) program on Sept. 27 when it hosts Adrian at 1 p.m. at Jack Britt Memorial Stadium. Kids ages 14 and younger will receive free admission with the purchase of a full-priced adult ticket. Lake Erie College is one off more than 200 schools participating in this NCAA-sponsored event this season.

ON THE RADIO: The game will be broadcast on WELW 1330 AM with a one-hour delay, but will include the pregame show and game in its entirety. Play-by-play will be provided by Kendall Lewis, "the Big Sports Kahuna."

ON THE INTERNET: The game will be broadcast on welw.com simultaneously with the radio broadcast. Fans will be able to listen to the game in upcoming weeks by clicking on the game link on the Storm football team's schedule and results page on the Lake Erie College athletics website.

THE COACHES: Mark McNellie (Baldwin-Wallace 1988) coaches the fourth varsity game of his career as a head coach this afternoon and is looking for his first career win. Lou Esposito (Memphis 2001) is in his fourth season with the Pumas who just won their first game in come-from-behind fashion last Saturday.
