

Registration Information

How does Registration Work?

At Orientation you will pre-register for your fall 2007 semester courses. You will receive your Lake Erie College network user name and password for your campus e-mail and computer account and your student record account user name and password. Your student record account is what you will need to proceed with registration.

Why Is It Called “Pre-registration”?

LEC considers you pre-registered until August 1, 2007 - the deadline for paying your semester bill. If you have satisfied your billing obligations, your registration becomes official. If you have not, your pre-registration will be cancelled and you will be removed from all classes. Once your billing has been satisfied, you may re-register for classes, but will be assessed the late registration fee.

How Do I Know What to Take?

Each student at Orientation will meet with a faculty advisor individually to choose a course schedule for the fall 2007 semester. The faculty advisors are experienced in advising and will be an important tool in helping you choose what courses are best for you.

To be a full-time student you must pre-register for at least 12 credit hours. Freshmen normally take 14 to 16 credit hours during their first semester. All freshmen register for HU110 Freshmen Experience. We recommend that freshmen take courses within the [General Education](#) requirements during their first year in college.
