Proficiency in the English Language

Students who are applying to Lake Erie College and whose first language is not English must demonstrate their ability to read, write, and speak English through the results of a recognized English language proficiency test. Lake Erie College currently accepts the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or the STEP test in Practical English Proficiency*. Minimum scores are as follows:

- TOEFL: For degree seeking undergraduate students, a paper score of 550, a computer score of 213, or an internet score of 79 is required. For degree seeking graduate students, a paper score of 570, a computer score of 225, or an internet score of 85 is required. Non-degree seeking students must produce scores of 500 on the paper test, 173 on the computer test, or 63 on the internet test.
- IELTS: for degree seeking undergraduates, we require score of 6.0 or higher. For degree seeking graduates, we require a score of 7.0. For non-degree seeking students, a score of 5.0 is required.
- STEP: We accept passing grades at the first and pre-first levels.
