

Presidential Honors Scholarship

The Presidential Honors Scholarship is Lake Erie's most prestigious scholarship. Five of these 90 % tuition scholarships are awarded to first-year students coming directly from high school.

Recipients become part of the Honors Program, which includes:

- Participation in specially planned on- and off- campus speakers, concerts, plays, and athletic events
- Community service projects planned and coordinated by the Honors Program
- The program is uniquely designed to combine the pursuit of academic excellence within an intensive cultural and social environment.

Criteria for award eligibility:

- The student ranks in the top five of the graduating high school class pursuing a college preparatory curriculum (4 units of English, 3 units of math, 3 units of social studies, and 3 units of science),
- 30 ACT/ SAT combined 1800

Minimum Requirements:

- The student ranks in the top five of the graduating high school class pursuing a college preparatory curriculum (4 units of English, 3 units of math, 3 units of social studies, and 3 units of science),
- Achieved a minimum Enhanced ACT score of 25 or SAT score of 1650.

Additional Criteria

- The applicant must complete a 2000 word essay reviewed by selection committee. Choose one of two Topics: What is the value of a liberal arts education? *Or* Why is a Lake Erie College a good college choice for you?
- The recipient must take part in the Honors Program
- The recipient must live on campus
- The recipient must maintain a 3.5 GPA and complete a minimum of 28 semester hours per academic year
- Students must maintain a full-time on-campus enrollment status of at least 12 credit hours per term.
- Applications are due by May 16, 2008
