Two 2009 Class Senators

On track to have earned a minimum 64 credit hours at the beginning of fall 2007; cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better; be a voting member of SGA; regularly report on class activities and related issues; ensure that there are not outstanding debts in class accounts at the end of the academic year and shall hold at least one class meeting per semester; attend all scheduled meetings of SGA

Two 2010 Class Senators

On track to have earned a minimum 32 credit hours at the beginning of fall 2007; cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better; be a voting member of SGA; regularly report on class activities and related issues; ensure that there are not outstanding debts in class accounts at the end of the academic year and shall hold at least one class meeting per semester; attend all scheduled meetings of SGA

Career Representative

On track to have earned a minimum 32 credit hours at the beginning of fall 2007; cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better; shall be a voting member of SGA; serve as a liaison between academically related student clubs and the Office of Career Services and SGA; attend all scheduled meetings of SGA

Equine Representative

On track to have earned a minimum 32 credit hours at the beginning of fall 2007; cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better; shall be a voting member of SGA; Equine Representative shall be a voting member of SGA and must be an equine major and active in at least one equine club or organization; attend all scheduled meetings of SGA

Community Service Representative

On track to have earned a minimum 32 credit hours at the beginning of fall 2007; cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better; shall be a voting member of SGA; will organize SGA service project each semester; serve as a contact person for students want to participate in community service projects; assist and initiate community service related projects/programs on campus; attend all scheduled meetings of SGA

Athletic Representative

On track to have earned a minimum 32 credit hours at the beginning of fall 2007; cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better; shall be a voting member of SGA; required to be a member of at least one Varsity Team; attend all scheduled meetings of SGA
